


Developed revolutionary farming techniques that helped former slaves in Alabama become selfsufficient.

Best known for her powerful voice and recording the theme songs for James Bond films.




Viv Anderson MBE


Became the first female and Afro-Brazilian governor of the State of Rio De Janeiro.

Olympic Heptathlon Champion






Jessica Ennis-Hill won Heptathlon gold at the London 2012 Olympic Games.


